



Thank you for joining us for the regional premiere of sandblasted. I am so glad you are here to experience the brilliant writing of Charly Evon Simpson on our stage for the first time ever, and to welcome back Director Cheyenne Barboza, whose production of *The Agitators* closed prematurely in March 2020.

What I love about this play is that it is truly theatrical; it's a script whose power is revealed by the stage. It can be viewed as Charly Evon Simpson's response to a Samuel Beckett's *Happy Days*, another play that centers a woman

in the sand and a dystopian future. Most exciting to me, however, is how *sandblasted* celebrates what theater also does: the power of community.

sandblasted explores being a Black woman in a society that is deeply hostile to Black women. It is ultimately a play about resilience, and how being in relationship with others allows you to reach deeper even when the well within yourself is dry. To me, it is also an interrogation of wellness culture, and our perpetual desire for self-improvement, sometimes at the peril of reaching for larger, systemic change. sandblasted presents a fictional version of reality, but what feels entirely recognizable is how life always contains the micro ("Am I eating enough spinach?) to the macro ("How do we mitigate the effects that racism has on Black bodies?). It asks, how do we live for ourselves and for each other?

sandblasted is our final production of the 2022/23 season, and we are excited to let you know what we have in store for 2023/24! It's been a thrilling journey as we continue to open our doors wider and wider. We're so glad to have you part of our Theatre Horizon community.





# **sandblasted** was rehearsed and performed at Theatre Horizon in Norristown, which stands on the territory known as "Lenapehoking," the ancestral home of the Lenape people.

For the past 10,000 years, the Lenape have been the original caretakers and stewards of Lenapehoking—one of numerous tribes that comprised tens of millions of people residing on this continent prior to the invasion of European colonizers.


We recognize that Isaac Norris, Sr.—Norristown's namesake—purchased land from the family of William Penn even though nobody "owns" Lenapehoking. We acknowledge that Isaac Norris, Sr. was a slaveholder who benefited from a system that captured, sold, and enslaved over 10 million Africans who were trafficked to various locations in North America, South America, and the Caribbean.

We acknowledge the 6 million African Americans that moved from the American South to the Northeast during The Great Migration and their role in making places like Norristown a central hub for industry and retail. Finally, with a large Latinx population in Norristown—particularly people from Puerto Rico and Mexico—we acknowledge the past, present, and future legacies of the Taíno and Aztec peoples.


