I grew up going to church every Sunday and choir rehearsal every Wednesday. One of my earliest memories of singing in front of

a group of people is singing a duet with my twin sister in front of our congregation. There is something special about a group of people singing together. I realized at a very young age that music has the power to transform us, to move us, to make us think about the world around us - together.

When I came out to my family and loved ones, I questioned whether I belonged in the place where I grew up. All my life, I was taught to believe that being a queer person was wrong, should be resisted, could somehow change. I feared my loved ones would turn away because of who I loved and how I loved, which felt like it went against everything I'd

been taught by the church. For a time, I tried everything I could to be like everyone, but the more I tried, the further I felt from my faith and from myself. I eventually distanced myself from the church as an institution.

Even in the toughest times, there was always Gospel Music in my life. In musical theatre, I discovered how many of my peers had grown up in church. We were drawn to the community and camaraderie that music could offer. Performing in *The Color Purple* brought me back to my faith and made me a stronger performer. I was no longer afraid to share my whole self.

There is nothing like Gospel Music. There is a song for every circumstance and for everyone. My hope for you today is - whether you are a regular churchgoer or you just want to hear amazing music - that you walk away with new ideas about the world and experience a moment of transformation. Thank you for spending some of your holiday with us. Enjoy.

Land Acknowledgement

The Holiday Gospel Concert was rehearsed and performed at Theatre Horizon in Norristown, which stands on the territory known as "Lenapehoking," the ancestral home of the Lenape people.

For the past 10,000 years, the Lenape have been the original caretakers and stewards of Lenapehoking—one of numerous tribes that comprised tens of millions of people residing on this continent prior to the invasion of European colonizers.

We recognize that Isaac Norris, Sr.—
Norristown's namesake—purchased land
from the family of William Penn even
though nobody "owns" Lenapehoking. We
acknowledge that Isaac Norris, Sr. was a
slaveholder who benefited from a system
that captured, sold, and enslaved over 10

million Africans who were trafficked to various locations in North America, South America, and the Caribbean.

We acknowledge the 6 million African Americans that moved from the American South to the Northeast during The Great Migration and their roles in making places like Norristown a central hub for industry and retail. Finally, with a large Latinx population in Norristown—particularly people from Puerto Rico and Mexico—we acknowledge the past, present, and future legacies of the Taíno and Aztec peoples.


