The Berserker Residents' shows include The Jersey Devil, The Giant Squid, The Annihilation Point (NYTimes Critics) Pick), The Lapsburgh Layover (commissioned by Ars Nova, NYTimes Critics Pick and Village Voice Critic Pick), The Very Merry Xmas Carol Holiday Adventure Show (commissioned by Theater Horizon and published by PlayScripts), It's So Learning (Presented by FringeArts and ASU Gammage), The Post Show (Presented at The Assembly in Edinburgh, Scotland) and Broccoli, Roosevelt, and Mr. House (commissioned by FringeArts). His work has been presented nationally and internationally at the Abrons Art Center, The San Francisco Mime Troupe, The Annenberg Center, The Assembly in Scotland, and ASU Gammage. He has been an artist in residence

with FringeArts, Drew University, Ars Nova (company in residence), and the University of the Arts.



Jacinta Yelland
(Mr. House) (she/her) is an Australian theatre creator and performer based in Philadelphia. She has collaborated with David Gordon,

Pig Iron Theatre Company, Quintessence Theatre Group, McCarter Theatre Center, Lightning Rod Special, People's Light, Philadelphia Artists' Collective, and Philadelphia Asian Performing Artists. She holds an MFA in Devised Performance from the University of the Arts/Pig Iron Theatre Company, completed the Zen Zen Zo Physical Theatre Company Internship, and was supported by Arts Queensland to study at École Philippe Gaulier, Paris. She is the Co-Artistic Director of the inFLUX Theatre Collective. Their debut show, The Choice, was co-produced by HERE Arts Center in New York City as part of their 2022 Co-Op

series. Jacinta's one-woman show *KOAL* was the recipient of the 5 Star Award at the 2023 Philadelphia Fringe Festival. Jacinta has been supported by the Australia Council for the Arts, Arts Queensland, American Australian Association, Network of Ensemble Theaters, City of Philadelphia, The Puffin Foundation Ltd., and The Work. She has been an artistin-residence at Fresh Ground Pepper (USA), Bethany Arts Community (USA), Les Rochers (France), and Brunåkra (Sweden).

The Berserker Residents (Creators) create original comedic productions that spring from improvisation and curiosity. We are guided by a desire to up-end theatrical conventions and create event-driven theater. The Berserker Residents comprise three Philadelphia-based wizards of imagination - Justin Jain, David Johnson, and Bradley K Wrenn. As collaborative performer-writers, we aim to plow the depths of the ludicrous and downright silly with one hand while making a firm connection to our audiences with the other. We have been hailed as "daft, ephemeral and joyous" by The Scotsman and have been praised for our "refusal to

relinquish that unrefined creative spirit" by The New York Times. We are a Barrymore-nominated ensemble and have received commissions from Theater Horizon (PA), Ars Nova (NY), ASU Gammage (AZ), and The University of the Arts (PA). Our work has been published by Playscripts, Inc. and presented at the Abrons Art Center (NY), The San Francisco Mime Troupe (CA), The Annenberg Center (PA), The Assembly (Scotland), and FringeArts (PA).

Land Acknowledgement

Broccoli, Roosevelt & Mr. House was rehearsed and performed at Theatre Horizon in Norristown, which stands on the territory known as "Lenapehoking," the ancestral home of the Lenape people.

For the past 10,000 years, the Lenape have been the original caretakers and stewards of Lenapehoking—one of numerous tribes that comprised tens of millions of people residing on this continent prior to the invasion of European colonizers.

We recognize that Isaac Norris, Sr.—
Norristown's namesake—purchased land
from the family of William Penn even
though nobody "owns" Lenapehoking. We
acknowledge that Isaac Norris, Sr. was a
slaveholder who benefited from a system
that captured, sold, and enslaved over 10

million Africans who were trafficked to various locations in North America, South America, and the Caribbean.

We acknowledge the 6 million African Americans that moved from the American South to the Northeast during The Great Migration and their roles in making places like Norristown a central hub for industry and retail. Finally, with a large Latinx population in Norristown—particularly people from Puerto Rico and Mexico—we acknowledge the past, present, and future legacies of the Taíno and Aztec peoples.
